2.3 Increase the price for Paid Lunch, Adult Lunch and Milk

Action Requested:

Approval.

Previous Staff/Board Action, Background Information and/or Statement of Need:

The District contracts with the Arcata School District to provide Food Service. This service is for lunches.

Our 2015-16 Food Service deficit was \$33,272.

For 2016-17 our cost per lunch is increasing from \$3.34 to \$3.40 and our cost per carton of milk is \$.50.

Our estimated 2016-17 deficit, using 2015-16 participation numbers and the 2016-17 cost per lunch increase and the cost per carton of milk is \$33,884.20.

Lunch:

For 2015-16 we charged \$.40 per lunch for Free lunches, \$3.75 for Paid (full pay students) lunches and \$4.00 for Adult lunches.

The amount we are allowed to charge for Free Lunches is set by the US Department of Agriculture Nation School Lunch Program. The amount we are allowed to charge for Paid and Adult lunches is at the discretion of the District.

The Paid and Adult lunches share of the estimated 2016-17 deficit is \$13,037.80, or \$1.87 per lunch. The administrative staff has concluded that it is unreasonable to subsidize what adults pay for school lunches.

The administrative staff recommends that we raise the price of Adult lunches to \$6.00 per lunch.

The administrative staff has also concluded that it is unreasonable to subsidize what full pay students pay for school lunches. However, the administrative staff has concluded that a price raise of \$ 1.87 per lunch is an excessive increase for full pay students to bear in one year.

The administrative staff recommends that we raise the price of Paid lunches by \$.50 to \$4.25 per lunch.

Milk:

For 2016-17 our cost for milk is \$.50 per carton.

We are only collect and are charged for milk when it is sold ala cart.

For 2015-16 we charged \$.25 per carton of milk.

The administrative staff recommends that we raise the price for a carton of milk by \$.25 to \$.50 per carton.
